Adding the Gift Feature to Your Existing Application

If your application has already been built and you would like to add the Gifts functionality to it, you will need to:

These tasks are detailed in the following sections of this document.

Creating New Facebook Gifts

You can create “gifts” that Facebook users can send to their friends to help spread the news about your application. Facebook gifts are simply images that may reflect the mission of your organization.

You can present the gifts to senders in a gift catalog page generated by the S61 tag. Each gift image contains a link to a Gift Details page that contains more information about the gift, its purpose, or your organization. You can provide content directly for the Gift Details page, or link to an existing Convio or external Web page to display.

To create a Facebook Gift:

1. Access the Convio Facebook Interface pages:
 - a. From the top-level navigation bar on an Administrator Interface page, click **Constituent360** and then click **Widgets**.
 - b. Click the **Facebook** tab on the **Widgets Campaigns** list page.

2. From the Process Navigator, click step 7. **Create Facebook Gifts**.
3. On the "Manage Facebook Gifts" list page, click the **Create New Facebook Gift** link.




Notes:

(1) If you will not be using the gift feature, click the **Finish** button on the bottom of the page to return to the first page.

(2) When you create each gift, you will provide a name and image as well as details about the gift, which may include the purpose or an appeal for your organization. These details will be kept on a Gift Details page that is accessed when the image is clicked. You can create the content on the page using the WYSIWYG Editor on the More Information page or link to an existing Convio page. You can also link to an external Web page.


(3) All gifts you create with the status Available will be presented to Facebook members via a Gift Catalog page, which is generated by the S61 tag. For information about modifying parameters in this S61 tag, refer to the [Convio Session \(S\) Tag documentation](http://twiki.convio.com/twiki/pub/Engineering/S61TagDocumentation/Convio_S-Tags_110807_cf.pdf) (http://twiki.convio.com/twiki/pub/Engineering/S61TagDocumentation/Convio_S-Tags_110807_cf.pdf).



4. On the "Enter Gift Details" page:
 - a. For gift name, enter the label that will display with this gift in Facebook.
 - b. For security category, leave **General** selected to allow all administrators to make changes to this gift, or click the appropriate option from the drop-down list to limit this control to a specific group.
 - c. For Gift Status, leave **Available** selected to make this gift available to be sent.




Note: Later, you can make this gift **Unavailable** if it can no longer be sent.

- d. For gift type, to optionally group this gift with other similar gifts:
 - o Select the appropriate option from the **Choose an existing value** drop-down list.
 - o *Or*, click the **Enter a new value** radio button and enter the name of a new type in the field provided.
- e. To upload the image file containing the gift that resides:
 - o In the Convio Image Library:
 - 1) Click the **Search the Image Library** button. The **Image Selector** pop-up displays with a list of available image files.
 - 2) To search for an image file on another page, enter the image title or file name in the **Search** field and click the **Search** button.
 - 3) Click the **Select**  icon from the **Actions** column of the appropriate image file. The thumbnail of the image displays on the current page.
 - o On your local computer or shared network resource:
 - 1) Click the **Browse** button.
 - 2) In the **Choose/Find File** window that opens, locate the image file on your local computer or shared network resource, select it, and click the **Open** button. The file name displays in the field.
 - 3) Click the **Upload Image** button. When it is uploaded, the thumbnail image displays along with options to **Delete this image** and **Upload a different image**.







Downloading Content Pages

To accommodate the gift feature, you will download the default content again to get the five gift page files you must customize. You must also make modifications to four existing files.

When you download the Default Content zip file more than one time, any pages that match the existing page names of the default content (for example, fb_wrapper_top) will not be downloaded, which means that any customizations you have made are safe.

For your convenience, we have provided an additional copy of the four existing files that must be customized for gifts feature (fb_homepage, fb_personal, fb_profile, and fb_wrapper_top,) by adding 01082008 to their file name.

If you have made customizations to the originals of any of these pages, you may want to open the new 01082008 files and copy the new information (which is described in the instructions in this document) into them rather than re-creating your customizations.

Alternatively, if you choose to use the 01082008 files instead, be sure to:

- 1) Rename your existing page to indicate that it is an obsolete page (e.g. rename fb_homepage to fb_homepage_old) and unpublish it
- 2) Rename the 01082008 file by removing the appended date (e.g. rename fb_homepage_01082008 to fb_homepage)
- 3) Unpublish and republish the newly renamed page

In addition the following gift pages will also be downloaded:

- fb_gift_page, a canvas page that contains the gifts Facebook members can select to send as well as the fields to send the gift and add a personal message
- fb_gift_sent_error, a page that displays to the Facebook member sending a gift if the gift is not successfully sent
- fb_gift_sent_success, a page that displays to the Facebook member sending a gift when it is sent successfully
- fb_my_gifts, a canvas page that shows the gifts the Facebook member has received
- fb_reuse_GiveGift, a canvas page that is called for display in a small section on other Facebook pages to encourage people to give gifts
- reuse_fbGiftStyle, which controls the appearance of the gift pages (*does not require customization*)



- fb_gift_sent_error, a page that displays to the Facebook member sending a gift if the gift is not successfully sent
- fb_gift_sent_success, a page that displays to the Facebook member sending a gift when it is sent successfully
- fb_my_gifts, a canvas page that shows the gifts the Facebook member has received
- fb_reuse_GiveGift, a canvas page that is called for display in a small section on other Facebook pages to encourage people to give gifts
- reuse_fbGiftStyle, a style sheet that controls the appearance of the gift information pages

6. Click the **Next** button. The **Edit Page Layout and Content** page opens.
7. Click the **Add Content** button. The HTML Editor window opens.
8. Click the **Source** button. The HTML and Convio source code displays in the HTML Editor window.
9. In the Editor window:
 - a. In the H2 tag, optionally replace the labels "Select Your" and "Gift!"
 - b. In the statement that begins with "Enter some content", replace the text with statements that describes your gifts and explains the purpose of sending them to other Facebook members to help encourage people to send gifts.



Note: The S61: gift-form tag pulls the gift catalog and sending form into this page. The gift catalog is a Convio page that you constructed added the gifts earlier.

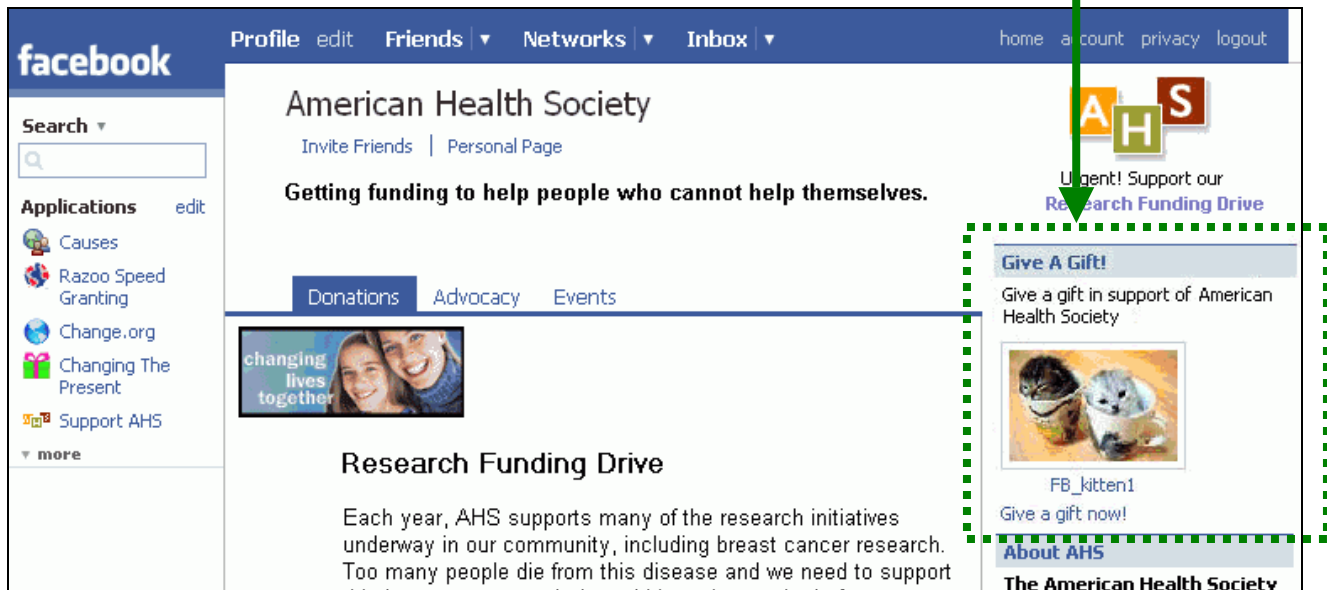

Customizing the fb_reuse_GiveGift Page

The fb_reuse_GiveGift page is a canvas page this is called for display in a small section on other Facebook pages to encourage people to give gifts.

This reusable page could look similar to the following when displayed on the homepage.

- c. Locate the "<!--This is a good place to put an org. image" area and replace the **ImageHere.jpg** with the appropriate name of the image as stored in the Convio Image Library (for example, 00003.jpg).
